2-Hour Carry Kit

Purpose: To be kept nearby at all times for immediate (within minutes) communication of damage reports during Resource Net Level 1 ops. Also used to remain in contact with Resource Net Level 2 while returning home to retrieve 12-hour Go-Kit. Items:

- HT (recommended min. 5W on 12V/2.5W on batt)
- Programmed with Cupertino frequencies
- Charged batteries for 2-3 hours operation
- Cigarette lighter adapter
- Mobile antenna (mag mount or existing mobile antenna)
- Notepad / pens
- Emergency county and city telephone contact list
- Cell phone
- Water (16 oz.)

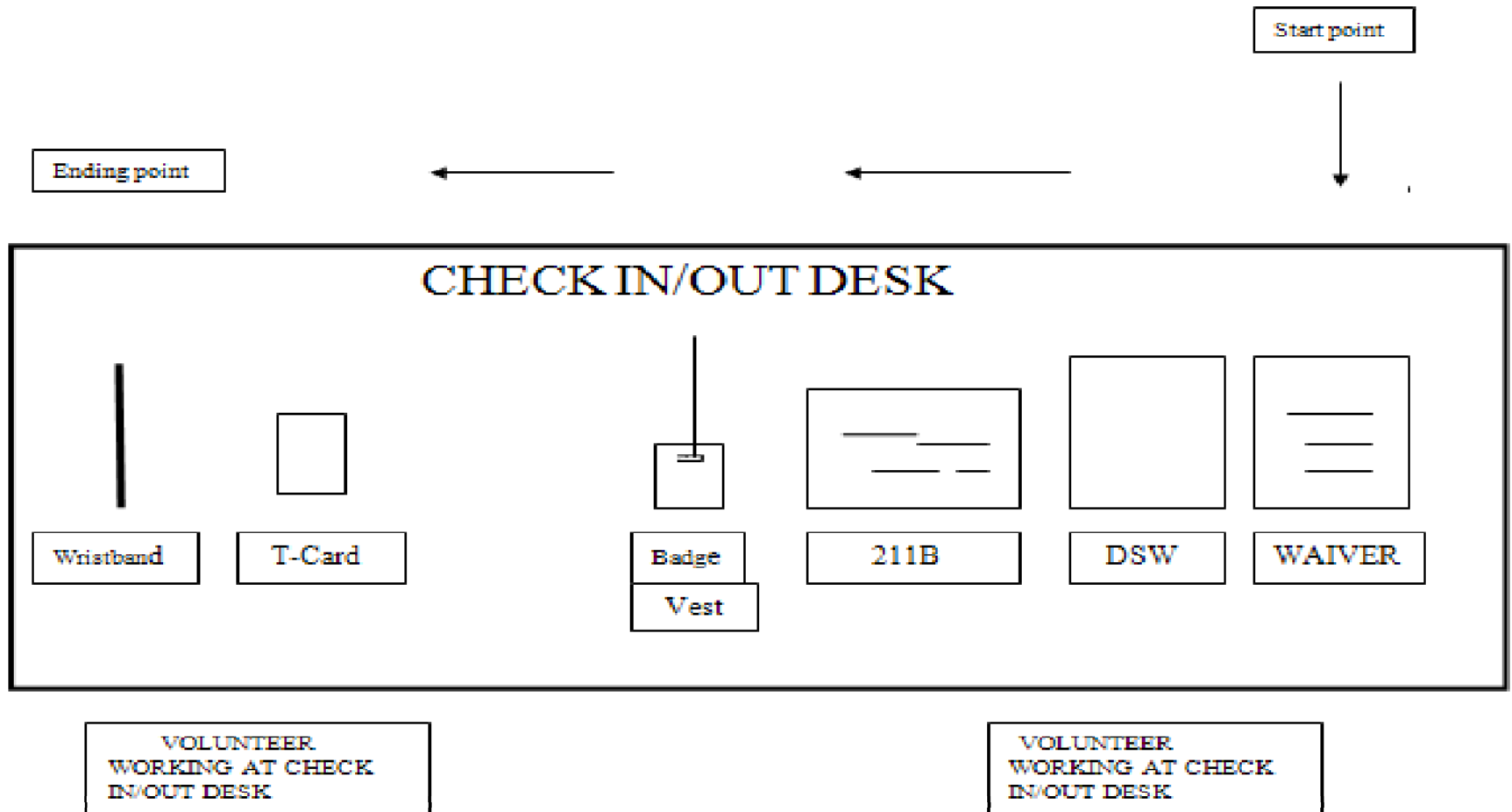
Bring your Badge & Vest



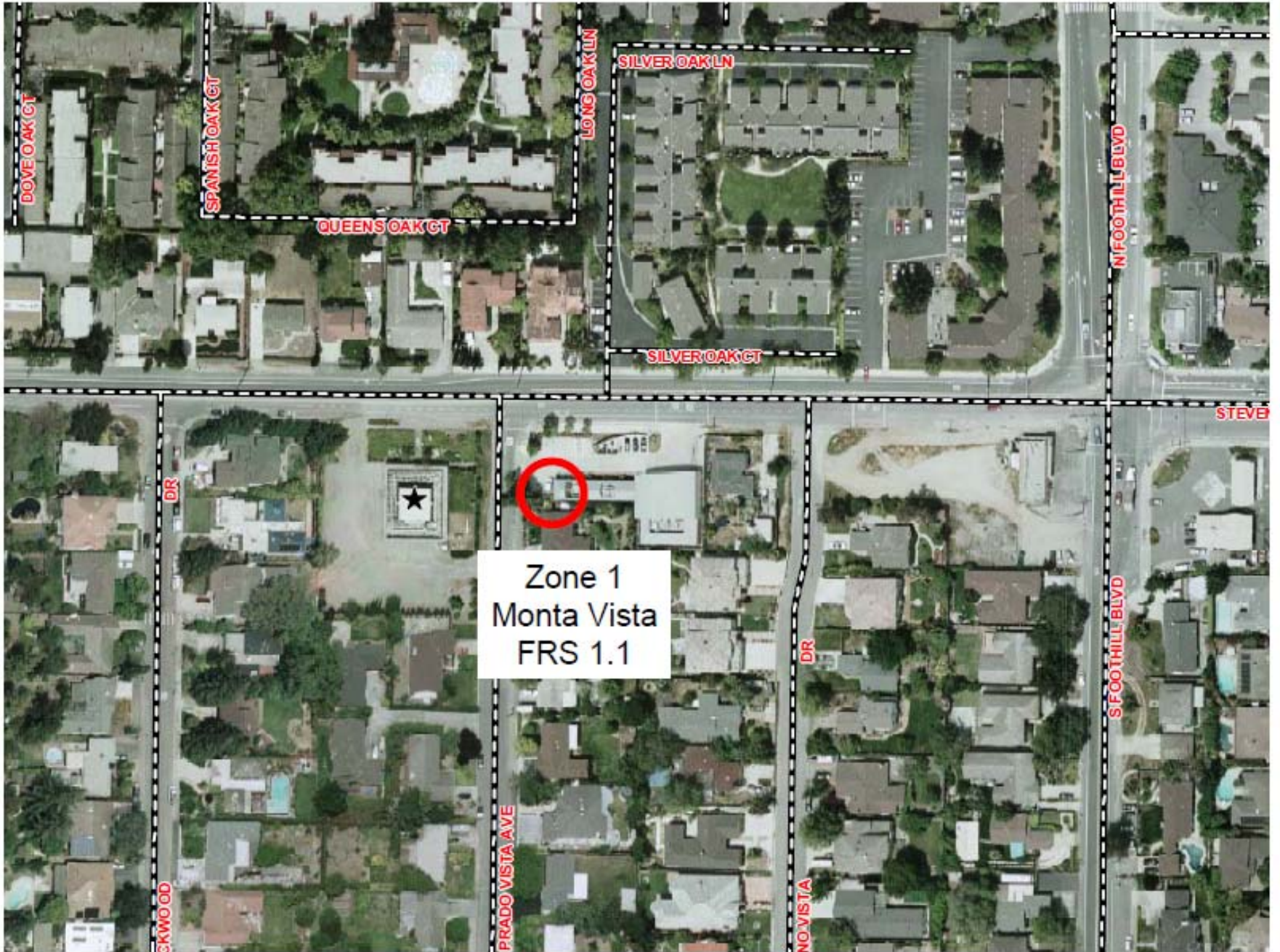

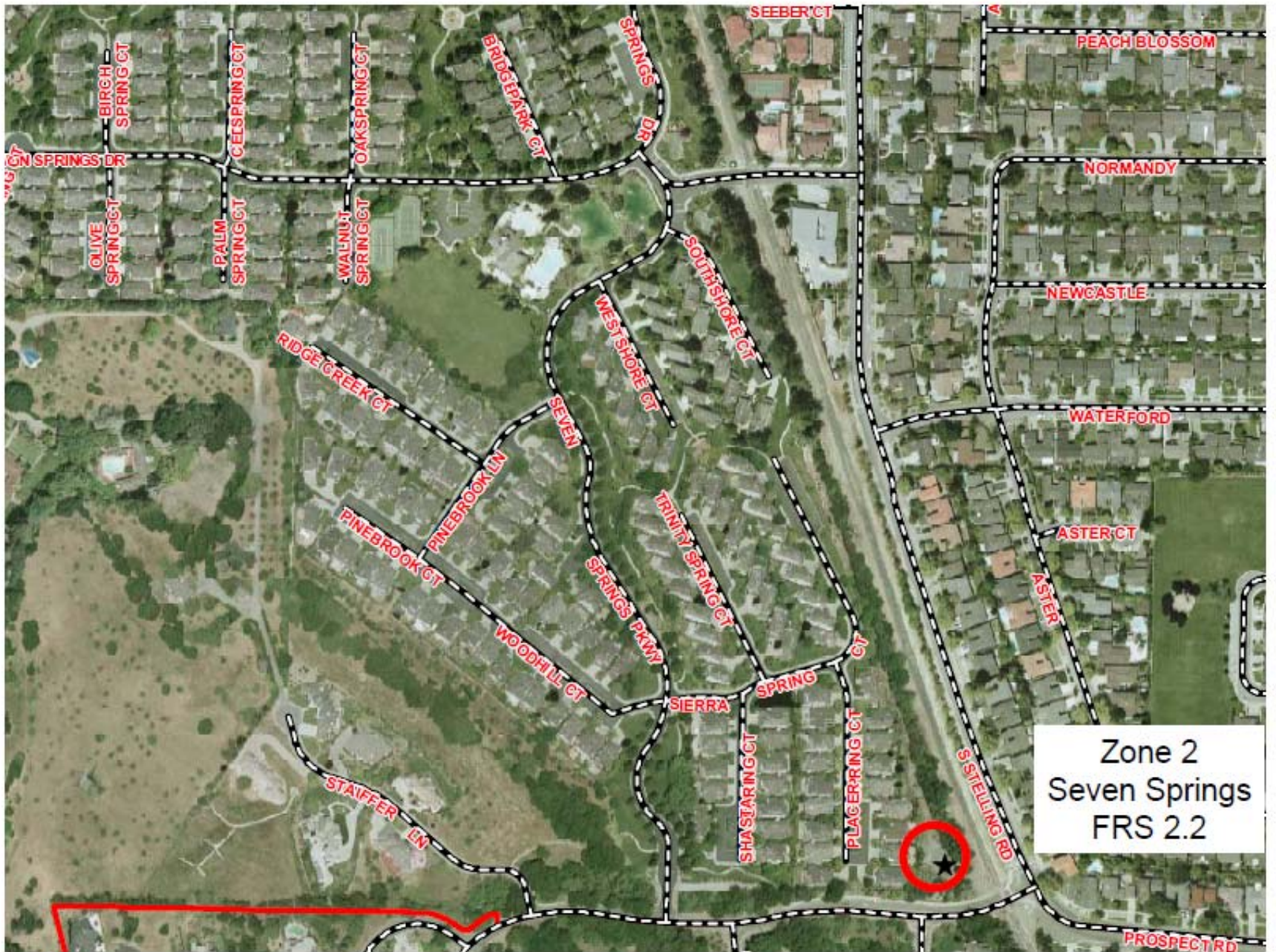
