

2018 Earthquake Exercise

December 15, 2018

Objectives

- Exercise radio operations on all designated nets.
- Exercise the ARK activation process to Activation Level 2.
- Exercise CCC (CARES and CERT) ISA team deployment. 3.
- Test the End to End Alt911 communications process. 4.
- Exercise an activation of the Cupertino Alternate EOC. 5.

- Test resource management over two operational periods. 6.
- Test initial Demob plan with a focus on forms completeness. 7.

Your feedback (in no special order)

What worked

- 1. Having 2 nets operating at once.
- 2. ISA maps, locations, and directions.
- 3. Good teamwork bet. CARES & CERT
- 4. ARK setup: easy & straight forward.
- 5. CERT and new CARES members had the a chance to send packet messages.
- 6. Packet worked well from the 5 opened ARKS
- 7. Message passing.
- 8. Assignment and deployment process.
- 9. Good radio reception from ARKs to Comm 469 at the Alternate EOC.
- 10. PSA Recorder process.
- 11. T-Cards 2nd shift made assignments and tracking much easier.

Didn't work/needs improvement

- 1. Not everyone had PL tone set.
- 2. Shift change and resource check-ins; Not closing down before 2nd shift arrives.
- 3. ARK Generator failed after 2 hours; could not start the other 4.
- 4. Need more clarification on the role of CERT at the ARK for Activation Level 2.
- 5. Alt911cts did not work on one system.
- 6. Alt911 msgs not always addressed right.
- 7. Not able to reach the EOC from some ISA locations.
- 8. GGA ARK door was difficult to open; no local restroom.
- 9. Paperwork flow of packet messages to Shift Supervisor.
- 10. Delay in making resource assignments.



Obj #1: Exercise Radio Operations on all nets

- 1. Collect Modified Mercalli Intensity Scale (Mike-Mike) Reports
 - RESULTS: worked well (first time)
 - PLAN: Look at incorporating Mike-Mike Reports into the initial check-in to generate an even more immediate impact assessment
- 2. Test the PSA Data Recorder Process
 - RESULTS: worked well
 - PLAN: Need to develop this as a fundamental packet capability across all CARES packet ops
- 3. Operate Message NCS from Comm 469 using an ARP Kit
 - RESULTS: worked well
 - PLAN: Look at power mgmt; On-going message passing practice



Obj #2: Exercise the ARK Activation Process to Level 2

- 1. ARK activation Process to Level 2
 - **RESULTS**: worked well
 - **PLAN**: ensure all CCC members have a copy of the ARK Activation Handbook

Obj #3: Exercise CCC ISA team deployment

- 1. Deploy joint CARES/CERT members on ISA teams
 - **RESULTS**: worked well; feedback was very positive
 - **PLAN**: reinforce go-kit contents availability
- 2. Comm 469 Packet Procedure for Passing ISA Traffic
 - **RESULTS:** worked OK; multiple messages sent to SJWC
 - **PLAN:** Need process reviews, improvements, practice
- 3. Deploy CERT members with Trunk Radio to CuSD
 - **RESULTS:** Not Tested; but gave to CERT Field Supervisor
 - PLAN: Test deploy of CERT to CuSD office to receive ISA report

Obj #4: Test the E2E Alt911 call taking system

Pass ALT911 messages from field


2018 Earthquake: Exercise Review

- **RESULTS**: worked well; feedback was very positive
- **PLAN**: compile, implement enhancement list from the responders

2. Staff County Comm

- **RESULTS**: Not Tested; equipment, access issue resolution pending
- **PLAN**: Work with County RACES and County Comm to resolve

Obj #4: Test the E2E Alt911 call taking system



Obj #5: Exercise from the Alternate EOC

1. Operate from Alternate EOC

- **RESULTS**: For CARES, Worked well. For the City, Needs Work; EOC infrastructure is not in place
- PLAN: City OES and Staff to outfit the Alternate EOC as an operational location

Obj #6: Test Resource Mgmt over 2 Op Periods

1. Resource Assignments

- **RESULTS:** Needs Work
- **PLAN**: Review process (Resource Readiness List), tools (T-Cards); need broader discussion on CCC resource planning and tracking (track CERT?)

2. Field Shift Change

- **RESULTS**: Needs Work; missing info on shift resource plans
- **PLAN**: Field Communications Handbook update; tighten up checklist

Obj #7: Test Initial Demob Plan

- 1. Test initial Demob plan with a focus on forms completeness
 - **RESULTS**: For the first time, worked OK.

2018 Earthquake: Exercise Review

- PLAN: (i) continue to emphasize the importance, completeness, and legibility of the event documentation,
 - (ii) determine the type and degree of documentation required
