- Practice crowd safety and management operations in conjunction with P&R and S.O.
- Practice first aid operations.



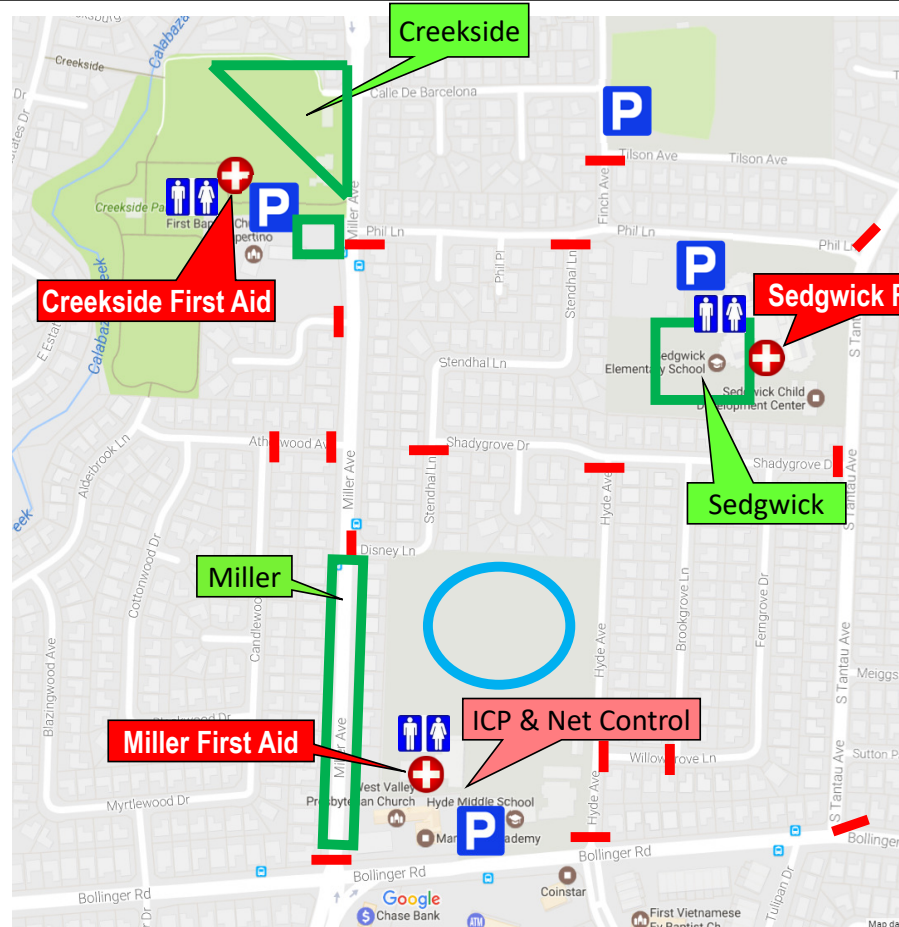
